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“It was a culture thing, and we talked about the culture around here slipping a little bit,” St. Arnauld said. “Ultimately, the buck stops with me. We’ve go to a better job holding each other accountable and making sure that culture doesn’t slip.

“It’s easy to come up with excuses, but we all need to look ourselves in mirror and fix it. Now, we’ve laid a road map. We are so laser focused on getting the culture back.”

In retrospect, Fort caught MH-B at the absolute worst possible time.

Not only were the Vikings angry, they’re beginning to get healthier.

Standout defensive end Henry Loger, who suffered a concussion in Week 2, then got the flu when he ready to return, was back to help ignite MH-B’s defense. Loger finished the night with three tackles for loss and four tackles overall.

Others are close to returning, as well.

“We could be really healthy by Week 8,” St. Arnauld said.

With MH-B hungry — and healthier — it took a month of frustration out on the Blackhawks.

The Vikings put up 30 first quarter points and 50 in the first half alone, while making sure the Blackhawks’ offense never got out of neutral.

“We were laser focused,” St. Arnauld said. “Our message was, ‘Go get it done.’”

Boy, did they ever.

Maier had an 8-yard touchdown run just 3 minutes into the game, then added the two-point conversion run to make it 8-0. Myers hit Cullen Olson with a 20-yard TD pass and Meier tacked on the conversion run that pushed MH-B’s lead to 16-0 with 7:08 left in the first.

Meier ripped off a 53-yard TD run and added the two-point conversion to make it 24-0 with 5:15 left in the opening quarter. And before the quarter was over, Myers hit Django Christian with a 36-yard TD to give MH-B a 30-0

lead.

Just 36 seconds into the second quarter, Myers and tight end Henry DeRosier connected on a 23-yard TD pass to give the Vikings’ a 36-0 advantage. Myers then found Sam Grundahl for a 46-yard TD midway through the second quarter as the Vikings’ lead ballooned to 43-0.

Haiden Jeglum then had a 6-yard TD run with 3:20 left in the first half and MH-B carried a 50-0 lead to halftime.

“We went back to the drawing board after Beaver Dam and asked ourselves which way are we going?” St. Arnauld said. “We couldn’t let that losing streak sideswipe the program.”

St. Arnauld went deep into his bench during an extremely fast moving second half.

And while there was a lot to like about MH-B’s bounce back win, perhaps the most positive development was the continued growth of Myers.

The sophomore quarterback completed 88.9% of his passes (8-of-9), aver-

aged 18.6 yards per pass attempt and threw four touchdowns.

“He played a really good game vs. Fort,” St. Arnauld said of Myers. “It’s unfair of us to ask a young QB to go win us a game. But he put us in good spots, threw a lot of terrific balls and has shown really good growth.”

Defensively, sophomore Barrett Slaney had a team-high seven tackles and two tackles for loss, Dilyn Randle had a fumble recovery and the Vikings finished with 10 TFL’s as a team.

Overall, it was the kind of effort the Vikings desperately needed — and one that gives St. Arnauld hope that his team can finish 2026 with a bang.

“If we can run the table and get to 6-3, we can get a (No.) 3-seed and be extremely dangerous in the playoffs,” St. Arnauld said. “If that happens, there’s not a team out there we’d be afraid of and I believe we could go and ruin somebody else’s season.

“But we’re not out of the woods yet. Not even close.”

• **On deck:** MH-B hosts Sauk Prairie (3-2, 2-1) in its Homecoming game Friday at 7 p.m.

The Eagles tied for the conference title last season with MH-B and Madison Edge-wood. Sauk Prairie has reached the playoffs two straight years after having gone just once between 2008-2023.

“Randy (Wallace) runs a great program over there,” St. Arnauld said of the Eagles. “Where Sauk is now vs. when I first got here is night and day. Randy’s done just a great job and I have a ton of respect for him.

“I always look forward to our games with Sauk. It’s going to come down to our style vs. their style. We just have to keep playing with the effort level we did last week (against Fort Atkinson) and I think we can continue to turn this thing around.”

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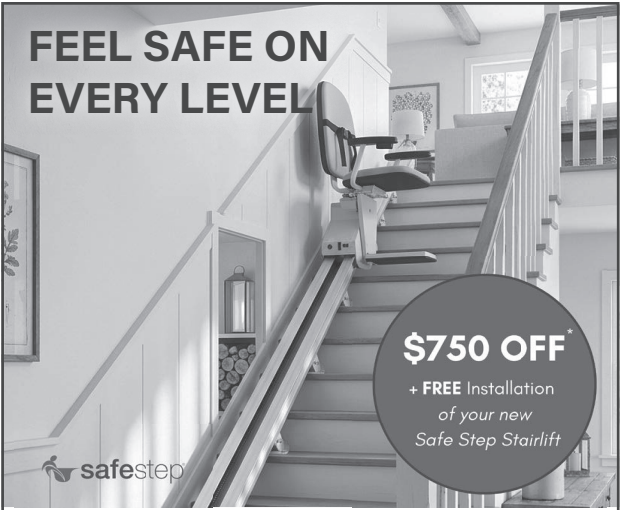
